COLONEL MARK W. WRIGHT

Colonel Mark W. Wright is the Commander of the 181st Intelligence Surveillance and Reconnaissance Group (ISRG), 181st Intelligence Wing, Indiana Air National Guard, Terre Haute, Indiana. As the Commander of the 181st ISR Group, he is responsible for providing qualified, trained, and proficient intelligence operators to support the Distributed Ground Station-Indiana (DGS) combatant commander tasked mission set as well as state mission requirements as directed by the Governor of the State of Indiana.

Colonel Wright began his military career with the United States Air Force in January of 1990 when he enlisted in the Indiana Air National Guard as an Aircraft Maintenance Technician Crew Chief on F-4E and F-16C fighter aircraft. In June of 1999 he was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant after graduating from the Academy of Military Science. After attending the Aircraft Maintenance Officer Course, Colonel Wright was assigned to the 181st Maintenance Squadron, 181st Maintenance Group, 181st Fighter Wing. In



December of 2000, he was selected as the Commander of the 181st Logistics Support Flight. During this period, Colonel Wright participated in OPERATION's NORTHERN WATCH, IRAQI FREEDOM, and ENDURING FREEDOM, Incirlik Air Base, Turkey. In 2006, he was selected to be the commander of the 181st Maintenance Squadron, 181st Maintenance Group. As the commander he supervised over 225 maintenance personnel and associated aircraft equipment valued at over 77 million dollars. During this period, Colonel Wright deployed as part of an Aerospace Expeditionary Force for a Pacific-Rim deployment to Kadena Air Base, Okinawa, Japan. In November of 2008 Colonel Wright cross-trained into the Intelligence Officer Career field and became part of the 137th Intelligence Squadron, Distributed Ground Station-IN (DGS-IN). In October of 2019 Colonel Wright took command of the 181st ISR Group. In his current position he is responsible for over 380 intelligence personnel trained in the processing, exploitation, and dissemination of mission critical intelligence data utilized by warfighters on a daily basis.
