Colonel L. Kip Clark is Commander of the 181st Intelligence Group, 181st Intelligence Wing, Hulman Field, Indiana Air National Guard, Terre Haute, Ind. Col Clark took charge of the 181st Intelligence Group on 21 November 2011, after serving as the 137th Intelligence Squadron Commander.

Colonel Clark enlisted in the Indiana Air National Guard in 1984 as a Heavy Equipment Operator. He was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in 1987 at the Academy of Military Science. He completed Undergraduate Navigator Training in 1988 and began his flying career as a Weapons Systems Officer in the F-4E.

In 1992 he completed pilot training and began flying the F-16C.
