Colonel Lisa K. Snyder is Commander of the Indiana Air National Guard's 181st Medical Group, Terre Haute, Ind. Col Snyder accepted command of the 181st Medical Group on 5 October 2014, after serving as Chief of Aerospace Medicine for the 181st Medical Group since August of 2010.

Col Snyder began her military career 5 September 2001 through direct commission into the Indiana Air National Guard as an Emergency Medicine Physician and soon thereafter, the Squadron Medical Element for the 113th Fighter Squadron. She served in that capacity until 2006 when she was selected as Chief of Aerospace Medicine, Standards Branch for the ANG and attended the Residency of Aerospace Medicine at Brooks City Base prior to filling that position at NGB/SG. During her tour at NGB/SG she had experience in forging the way for the ANG in many matters such as PRP, Active Associations of units and international disaster response assistance.



Upon accepting a Chief Quality Officer position at Select Medical in Pennsylvania, she resigned her full time orders to be a traditional guardsman and returned to the 181st MDG team in 2010, as the Chief of Aerospace Medicine. She has continued to assist NGB as the Medical Officer for several Safety Investigation Boards, various projects and Sexual Assault investigations.
