MONTGOMERY GI BILL CHANGES

The Department of Defense has implemented a change to the GI Bill program and has eliminated the Chapter 1607 REAP program.

If you were using the 1607 GI Bill for the Fall 2015 semester, then the program will continue for you. If you were not (used in the past or never used), then you will need to either use the Chapter 1606 or the Post 9/11 GI Bill. The 1607 will not be available.
