Qualifications:

1. Specialty Summary. Commands CERFP Medical Element whose primary mission is to respond to Homeland Security (HLS) and Homeland Defense (HLD) contingencies in order to provide medical support to civil authorities in Indiana, FEMA Region V, or CONUS/OCONUS to save lives, relieve suffering, and to calm the public.

2. Duties and Responsibilities:

- 2.1. Commands medical element. Commands resources engaged in medical support to domestic operations. Ensures maximum interoperable communications, equipment, personnel, and plans coordination in support of large scale CBRN event.
- 2.2. Maintains active rapport and working partnerships with organizations supporting CERFP Medical Element requirements, including Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) and Training Affiliation Agreements (TAAs).
- 2.3. Provides oversight of ANG element capabilities during collective exercise planning meetings and ensures representation of ANG for CERFP Battalion Command engagements.
- 2.4. Advises and educates state leaders and interagency partners on the medical capacity of state National Guard CBRN response.
- 2.5. Coordinates health care service activities. Conducts staff meetings, convenes, and appoints boards, councils, and committees to assist in managing assigned activities. Coordinates training, support, and use of medical elements and activities. Coordinates with local health care agencies. Participates in civilian community health planning process.
- 2.6 Reports to the MDG/CC and serves as a liaison with the Medical Group and ensures IMR requirements are maintained by all CERFP personnel.
- 2.7 Ensures a safe environment upon which members function, to the best the circumstances of the situation allow.
