COLONEL CHARLES T. GOAD

Col. Charles T. Goad is the Commander of the 181st Intelligence Wing, Indiana Air National Guard, Hulman Field, Terre Haute, Indiana. He assumed command of the 181st Intelligence Wing on 1 August 2022. He is responsible for more than 900 military and civilian personnel who execute a broad spectrum of missions involving Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance, Air Support Operations, CBRNE Enhanced response Force Package, and Agile Combat Support.

Col. Goad began his military career by enlisting in the United States Army, Military Police, in 1991. He attained the rank of sergeant in under four years as a Military Policeman but left the Army after five years to attend college full-time. While waiting to attend Ball State University, Goad enlisted in the Indiana Army National Guard. After completing college, Goad transferred to the Air National Guard as a Security Forces Journeyman. He was commissioned as an officer in 2002 and started his officer career as a Finance Officer. Goad has worked militarily for the Drug Enforcement Administration for two years, six years as a Fort Wayne Police Officer and fifteen years as a Reserve Officer for several police departments as a patrol officer, SWAT perimeter member and in command positions. Prior to his current position, the Colonel was the Deputy Commander, 52nd Mission Support Group, Spangdahlem, Germany.
