

COLENEL RYAN K. "RED" HARVEY

Col Ryan Harvey is the Commander of the 181st Intelligence Wing, Indiana Air National Guard, Hulman Field, Terre Haute, Indiana. He assumed command of the 181st Intelligence Wing on 3 May 2025. He is responsible for more than 900 Airmen and civilian personnel who execute a broad spectrum of missions involving Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance, Contingency Response, Combat Weather, CBRNE Enhanced response Force Package, and Agile Combat Support.

The Colonel commissioned through ROTC in March 2002 after graduating from Indiana University. He then completed Undergraduate Navigator Training in April 2003 and began his flying career as a B-52H Navigator. Over the next several assignments, Col. Harvey performed nuclear deterrence and continuous bomber presence roles as a B-52H aircrew member. During his initial Air Liaison Officer tour, Col. Harvey served as the night Officer in Charge at the Air Support Operations Center, Camp Victory, Iraq during OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM's crucial surge of 2007. In 2012, after completing initial cadre duties for stand- up of the 69th Bomb Squadron, Col. Harvey transitioned from active duty to the Indiana Air National Guard. As a new Guardsman, he immediately led 113th Air Support Operations Squadron



Airmen in OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM. This deployment marked the first time in history that Indiana Air National Guard Airmen directly supported Indiana Army National Guard Soldiers in combat.

Colonel Harvey then served as Commander, 113th Air Support Operations Squadron. Prior to assuming his current position, Col. Harvey served as the Director, Regional Support Directorate, where he led the Wing's four geographical and mission separated units and Air Range Complex. Col. Harvey served as a Strategic Planner for the Indiana Air National Guard, as well as a member of the Air National Guard Strategic Master Plan team. Prior to his current position, the Colonel was the Director of Plans and Requirements, Joint Force Air Component Indiana, Indianapolis, Indiana.
