Colonel Matthew C. Brown is the Vice Wing Commander of the 181st Intelligence Wing, Hulman Field, Indiana Air National Guard (ANG), Terre Haute, Indiana. Col. Brown was assigned to this position on 27 February 2017. He is responsible for more than 900 military and civilian personnel who execute a broad spectrum of missions involving Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR); Air Support Operations Squadron; and CBRNE Enhanced Response Force Package.

Col. Brown entered the Air Force in 1987 as an Airman in the 181st Civil Engineering Squadron. In 1997 he was commissioned as an intelligence officer through the Academy of Military Science. He has served in various positions including Chief of Intelligence, 181st Operations Support Flight, Intelligence Liaison Officer to Air Combat Command, Langley, Virginia, and Chief, ISR Strategic Plans and Integration Branch, National Guard Bureau, Arlington, Virginia. Col. Brown is a full-time Active Guard and Reserve (AGR) officer.

Col. Brown has served in multiple in-theatre deployments in support of Operations NORTHERN WATCH and IRAQI FREEDOM. He also deployed in support of PACOM THEATRE SUPPORT PACKAGE. He has been a Distributed Ground Station Mission Operations Commander where he supported Operations IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM, INHERENT RESOLVE, and FREEDOM'S SENTINEL combat missions.



Prior to his current position, Col. Brown was the Commander of the 181st Intelligence Surveillance, and Reconnaissance Group, Hulman Field, Indiana Air National Guard, Terre Haute, Indiana.
